

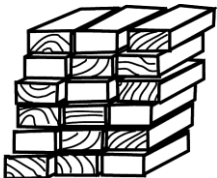
Wood Products

Hidden in the puzzle below are twenty more products with ingredients from trees. The words read up, down, backward and forward.



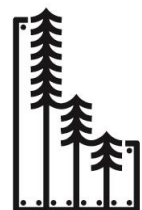
